



Supervised Fieldwork FAQ

What will supervision look like?

- Supervision includes live skill observations, meetings, structured practice opportunities for unrestricted tasks, and regular ongoing feedback.

Will I get group supervision, individual supervision, or both?

- Depending on the needs of your program, the responsible supervisor will discuss your tailored supervision plan with you prior to fieldwork beginning. Both individual and group supervision opportunities are available.

Can I work part-time and still receive supervision?

- Yes, both part-time and full-time placements are available.

Will I be able to work with a variety of clients?

- Yes. As part of the APL model, behavior technicians most often work with three to four clients per school year within the same age group.

How much does supervision cost?

- Supervision is offered for free by on-site supervisors as a benefit of your continued employment at APL.

Will I have opportunities for unrestricted hours?

- Students will have dedicated time for unrestricted hours within their scheduled workday. Tasks will be assigned based on their demonstrated skill set, training, and area of interest.
